BIKE RODEO SUCCESS

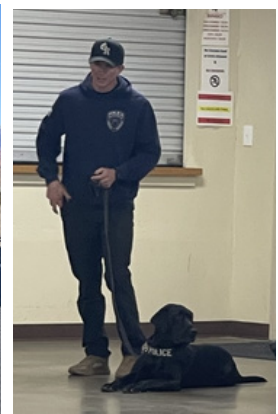

DUES PAYMENT REMINDER

As the new Elk year quickly approaches, we ask all members to please pay their dues as soon as possible. All dues payments must be made on or before March 31. Dues notices are currently being mailed out, and payments may be made during regular business hours at the Lodge. If possible, please bring your dues statement with you when making payment.

Payments are accepted by cash, check, or card. Spouse cards are available for a \$5 fee; members who have a spouse and would like a spouse card are asked to include this amount with their dues payment.

Any member who has not paid by April 1 will not carry over into the new Elk year, as Grand Lodge requires current membership information by that date. Please be aware that the key scanner will be changed on April 1, and prior key cards will no longer work. Members who are not paid and in good standing after April 1 will not be permitted entry into the Lodge and will be asked to leave until dues are paid, per Grand Lodge statutes.

Base dues for the 2026–2027 Elk Year are \$88. If you would like to help kick-start our year by supporting Lodge charities, we kindly ask members to consider paying the full amount of \$108.65. Any additional amount — whether partial or full — will be donated toward our charitable efforts. Please remember that your dues are tax-deductible each year.

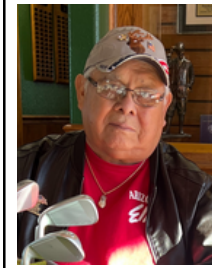
